She lives in Brahmapada village near Delhi, staying separately since she turned up at the office of Modi's superintending officer and submitted an RTI.

Application says that it was a matter of 'life and death'. Chief Justice Goolbsri's investigation, Jashodben demanded all the details of her personal belongings, saying that she and her family members were 'very scared' of them. In her three-page letter, she also demanded Modi's wife's details, she has also demanded copies of all the orders pertaining to the security provided to her. Jashodben has been provided protection by the special operations group (SOG) of Modi's security force. Jashodben has become active in social life and has been seen attending events, while expressing her desire to stay with the PM in Delhi.

Talking to TOI, she alleged that her guards were demanding that they be treated like 'prisoners'. "When I ask them to show the orders under which they are deployed, they don't have any answers," she said.
