

TVK lacks numbers to form govt: Guv

Chennai, May 7

TAMIL NADU GOVERNOR Rajendra Vishwanath Arlekar on Thursday rejected TVK chief Vijay's claim to form the government, stating that his party lacks the requisite numbers, adding another layer of political uncertainty and prompting the single-largest party to step up efforts to seek support again from the Left parties, VCK and the IUML.

Vijay visited the Lok Bhavan, based on an invitation from Governor Arlekar, for the second time in 24 hours. "During the meeting, the Hon'ble Governor explained that the requisite majority support in the Tamil

Nadu Legislative Assembly, essential for forming the government, has not been established," Lok Bhavan said in a statement after the meeting.

Amid renewed efforts by the TVK to reach out to them, the Left parties, VCK and IUML said a decision on Vijay's request for support will be taken tomorrow.

However, indications that they may extend support to Vijay emerged when VCK chief Thirumavalavan joined the Congress and the Left to con-

demn Arlekar's decision not to invite Vijay to form the government despite TVK emerging as the single largest party with 108 seats in the 234-member Tamil Nadu Assembly.

Also, according to sources, Vijay was open to accommodating prospective allies in his cabinet. As gubernatorial discretion and coalition arithmetic played out in Tamil Nadu, many interpret the delay as more political than administrative or constitutional.

"Experts say that the governor cannot demand a list of 118 MLAs who will support the government, and our view is that the BJP is creating confusion in Tamil Nadu politics," Thirumavalavan told reporters.

From drones to weapons & modern tech: Armed forces take fast route to shopping

REORGANISING ITSELF INTO a more agile and functional fighting force, more so post Operation Sindoor, the Indian military has made large-scale emergency procurement of modern weapons and technology to change the way it fights future wars.

The acquisitions over a year include a variety of drones, loitering munitions, counter-unmanned aerial systems, standoff weapons, including guided munitions and missiles. Several radars and electronic warfare equipment have also been procured through the fast-track route.

According to officials familiar with the developments, Operation Sindoor and ongoing conflicts abroad have provided key insights into how future wars will be fought, and the measures being discussed and implemented by the Indian armed forces are in line with the evolving realities.

Defence Secretary RK Singh, speaking at a security summit organised last month by news agency ANI, said Operation Sindoor, the Russia-Ukraine war and the West Asia war have shown the importance of standoff weaponry, of a layered and strong air defence system, of sufficient stockpiles of munitions and missiles and "of ensuring that your radars are mobile and your artillery is also mobile".

Underlining that these lessons have been applied to refine Indian defence procurement strategies, Singh said the majority of the ₹30,000-crore emergency procurement contracts, signed after Operation Sindoor, were intended to acquire drones, counter-drone systems, loitering munitions, various types of radars, and electronic warfare equipment.

According to officials, Operation Sindoor showcased the efficiency of air defence systems – like the S-400 missile systems in providing a sky shield against incoming aerial threats and achieving the longest-ever surface-to-air kill from a distance of 300 km – and also demonstrated the criticality of standoff weapons, particularly long-range beyond visual range missiles, and precision-guided artillery rounds.

The weapons used by the Indian Air Force during the strikes on targets in PoK and Pakistan included Scalp cruise missiles which allowed fighter aircraft to attack ground targets from standoff ranges.

Additionally, the operation featured the use of Hammer smart weapon systems, BrahMos missiles and guided bomb kits. The Army utilised artillery guns and Excalibur precision-guided artillery rounds.

India also used a variety of loitering munitions to target Pakistani military installations, doing away with the need to physically cross borders while

maintaining the ability to strike deep inside enemy territory.

During the hostilities, Pakistan deployed the China-supplied PL-15E beyond-visual-range air-to-air missile (BVRAAM), providing India insights into its capabilities.

India is said to be acquiring the R-37 long-range air-to-air missile from Russia and plans to induct the homegrown Astra BVRAAM and variants to enhance its arsenal of standoff weapons. And 216 Excalibur precision-guided 155mm artillery projectiles are being bought from the US.

Other than large-scale fast-track procurement of modern technologies and weaponry, the Indian military, particularly the Army, has also been reorganising itself into smaller, lethal functional units equipped with modern weaponry for future wars.

The Army is raising Ashni platoons, Bhairav battalions, Rudra brigades, Shak-tibaan regiments, Divyastra batteries and is working towards establishing integrated battle groups.

Suwendu aide murder: Police recover car, bike used in attack

A DAY AFTER Suwendu Adhikari's personal assistant Chandranath Rath was shot dead in Madhyamgram, near Kolkata, the police on Thursday said they had seized the car that had been used to block the road in which Rath's car was travelling, as well as the motorbike that the assailants rode. The police have also set up a Special Investigation Team (SIT) comprising the CID, the Intelligence Bureau, and a Special Task Force.

This came on a day Adhikari claimed that Rath might not have been killed had he not worked for him, while Rath's mother alleged that the killing was linked to the Trinamool Congress's defeat in Bhabanipur. "I would not have suffered so much had he died in an accident. He was targeted because he worked for Adhikari," she said, adding that she wants the culprits to get a life term and does not want them hanged.

The Governor, meanwhile, has issued a notification dis-

solving the West Bengal Assembly even as outgoing CM Mamata Banerjee refused to resign, a day before the BJP Legislature Party meets to elect the new CM.

The police said they were scanning CCTV footage and that the Border Security Force (BSF) had been alerted so that the killers cannot cross the border into Bangladesh. "The number plate has been tampered with and it belongs to someone in Siliguri. We have seized cartridges and live rounds from the

spot. We are processing all the evidence and speaking to the witnesses. Investigation is on," said DGP Siddh Nath Gupta.

Police sources said the car and the motorbike-borne assailants were present where the shooting took place hours before the incident. "CCTV footage showed that the car was present on the service road at Nowaikhali Bridge about a kilometre and a half from the place of occurrence about three hours before the incident," said a senior police officer.

Venugopal backed as CM by Kerala MLAs

AN "OVERWHELMING" MAJORITY of the Congress's newly elected MLAs, as well as state MPs, in Kerala favour AICC general secretary in-charge of organisation, KC Venugopal, for the post of Chief Minister. Sources said this is what they have told central observers sent for the selection, leaving the Congress with a tricky and complicated problem.

While Venugopal is not an MLA, and the party's central leadership had resolved in the run-up to the polls not to field MPs in the state elections, his selection may not go down well with Congress workers either. They feel VD Satheesan, the outgoing Leader of the Opposition, has earned the CM's post after leading the party's fight against the Left in the state.

Apart from Venugopal and Satheesan, veteran Congress leader Ramesh Chennithala is in the race. Sources said Satheesan has made it clear that he was not interested in any post other than that of the CM – which could also be a bargaining tactic.

On Thursday, kickstarting the process of selection of the

new Congress Legislature Party leader, the newly elected MLAs met in Thiruvananthapuram in the presence of AICC observers Ajay Maken and Mukul Wasnik.

The Congress dilemma Satheesan, for all practical purposes, was the face of the Congress and UDF campaign, after having led the offensive against the Pinarayi Vijayan government for the last five years as the LoP.

The IUML – the second-largest party in the UDF, with 22 MLAs – also favours Satheesan, particularly because of the stringent positions he has taken against majoritarianism. —ENS
